**(Discern – Institute for Research on the Signs of the Times)**

The ideal candidate must have:

- a University Degree (at EQF Level 7) in the Social Sciences, Economics, or Public Policy. Applicants with an EQF level 7 qualification in other related areas may be considered;
- a track record of quantitative research, although experience of qualitative research is also considered an asset;
- evidence of very good report-writing skills;
- experience in public speaking, presentations and event organisation;
- excellent verbal and written communication skills; and
- the ability to work with and in a team, and to work on his/her own initiative.

The successful applicant who will report to the Chief Research Officer (Discern), will develop and/or assist the latter in the development and execution of research projects. For this purpose, s/he must handle sensitive and confidential information appropriately and with discretion.
