

Project worker Role Description

JOB OVERVIEW *The Community Prevention team within Fondazzjoni Sebh in collaboration with Active Citizenship Fund is looking to recruit an energetic and motivated **Project Worker** to support their project “Our Community, Our Space – Young People Speak Out”. This project will run for 18 months, starting in January 2021. This is a community-based project that targets residents of Hamrun and Marsa.*

The aim of this project is to give a safe space for children and young people to speak out, through drama, about issues that concern them about the safety in their community. Stakeholders and parents will also be involved in this research. A Youth Platform will be formed as part of the project in order to have young people involved in every stage of the project and will be responsible for the presentation of the findings at the end of the project which will be presented to the community. An action plan will be drawn up following the presentation of the findings.

THE ROLE The **role** of the project worker is to support the Community Prevention team in facilitating this process. The project worker will be accountable to the team manager. The hours required are up to **ten hours per week** upon recruitment until the termination of the project. Working Hours can be flexible and discussed with CP team in accordance with on-going activities at the time.

QUALIFICATIONS Minimum qualification required is a degree in Youth & Community work/Social & Work/ Psychology or other equivalent degrees in social studies.

SKILLS We are looking for a person who is:

- Highly motivated

- Takes initiative in work
- Has experience in working with children/young people
- Has the necessary skills to work well in a team
- Has a clean police conduct

RESPONSIBILITIES

Responsibilities include:

- Liaising with CPT workers, drama therapist and research agency.
- Being involved in supporting drama therapy workshops with young people
- Supporting CPT team with necessary administration related to the project
- Initiating the setting up of the youth platform and supporting them through the process
- Mentoring young people in generating ideas and presenting them to stakeholders
- Forming relationships with parents and stakeholders in the community
- Report Writing
- Supporting Youth Platform/CPT team in organising final conferences where results will be presented
